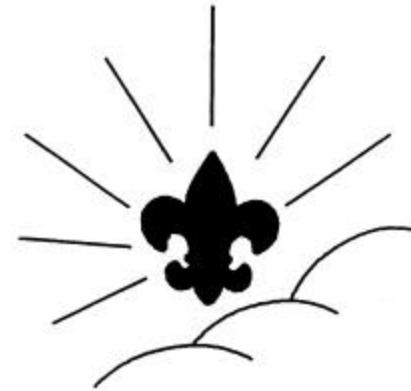
Please keep the thoughts in our minds, the words on our lips, and the intentions in our hearts pure. Help us always to do our best in all things and at all times. Amen.
